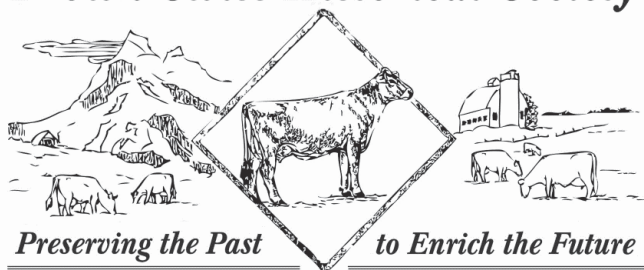

Introduction

Last month, we listed the Breed Champions for Milk and Fat. This month, we are listing Breed Champions for Protein. In the late 70's and early 80's, protein testing first became available. Many herds did not initially test for protein and processing centers (DRPC's) needed to reprogram to process those records. So in the early years, breeders needed to send those protein records directly to the Association to be recognized. Initially, only 305-day records were received, with 365-day and complete records following later. The first Breed Champion for Protein was recognized in 1982. Breed Champions remain until another cow breaks her record.
