## Individual Cow Awards

### *J.P. Eves Trophy* (305d 2x ME Milk)



Joe Eves is credited with starting the Intercollegiate Dairy Cattle Judging Contest at the National Dairy Cattle Congress as well as the Herdsman Contest. Mr. Eves was a nationally-known judge of all dairy breeds. He was a founder and, through the years, the most dedicated servant of Dairy Shrine as its long-time Secretary.

Mr. Eves always had a special fondness for the Brown Swiss cow and owned many over the years. Professionally, he served as Vice-President of Meredith Publishing Company. The articulate cattle judge once stated, "A full life involves education, family commitment, and a feeling of contribution to society, in general, and your community, in particular. I feel that the breeding of good registered livestock comes closest to permitting the farm family to achieve this goal."

### *H. R. Searles Trophy* (305d 2x ME Fat)



Harold Searles served as Extension Dairyman in Minnesota from 1922 until his retirement in 1960. He is remembered as one of the great Brown Swiss classifiers of all time, as well as a keen judge of dairy cattle shows. He was a leader in organizing cooperative artificial breeding associations and was Superintendent of the Cattle Department at the National Dairy Cattle Congress for over 25 years.
