

Visiting the Past . . .

Introduction

During the past two months this page has reviewed the various Production Recognition programs of the Association since 1912. During January and March the Visiting the Past (VTP) page presented the Award History of two programs which involved both Show and Production components. Those were the Total Performance and Cow For All Seasons awards. Those history lists and the ones to follow will be available on the Association website and updated yearly. We will now begin with the various Production Awards History.

Breed Champions – R.O.P. Records (3x or 4x)

The Registry of Production (ROP) program was adopted in 1911 with the first Breed Champions for milk and fat recognized in 1912. Cows were milked 3 or 4 times a day and the records were hand calculated at the National Office. Listed below are the Breed

Champions from 1912 for ROP records of cows milked 3x or 4x up to 1966 when the ROP program was discontinued. Breed champions for cows milked twice a day was established in 1940 and will be in next month's VTP page.
