Junior Associate memberships are issued at a one-time cost of \$10 to any individual less than 8 years of age. Junior associate member status qualifies those juniors not eligible for regular junior membership, to register animals at membership rates.

Membership Requirements

- Members must be less than 8 years old as of January 1 of the current year.
- Members must have title to at least one registered Brown Swiss female recorded in his or her individual name. (RF, ID or IDR animals do not qualify).
- Members must not yet have turned 8 years old on January 1 of the current year.
- Membership must be taken out in the same name in which the junior registers his or her animals.

Junior Associate membership entitles the individual to register the progeny out of cows registered in his or her name at membership rates, but does not entitle the individual to any other junior membership privileges (junior programs, shows, voting, etc.) of the Association.
