The Historical Society has recently received two major donations. The Hushon Family has donated the only known Model Brown Swiss Bull in existence. Shelburne Farms donated the proceeds of a calf sold in the Eastern Breeders Sale.



Hushon Family: At the 2000 National Convention Fun Auction held in Harrisburg, Pennsylvania, the top two items sold were one-of-a-kind bull and cow prototype Brown Swiss figurines. They were consigned by the Kruse family, in memory of Marvin

L. Kruse, long-time Executive Secretary of the Association. These figurines (models) were originally made for replication in the 1960's, but it never went into reproduction. The bull figurine was sold for \$2,000 to H. E. Heindel & Sons. Through the years the

bull figurine was recovered by the Hushon Family. This past fall during World Dairy Expo, the Hushon family donated the bull figurine to the Historical Society. The BSHS thanks and appreciates this wonderful one-of-a-kind donation.
