

NATIONAL BROWN SWISS ASSOCIATION 2022 Youth Scholarship

The Brown Swiss Association awards a **\$1000 scholarship**, annually to youth pursuing a degree in agriculture or a dairy-related field. Applicants are encouraged to reapply each year. Additional Scholarships are sponsored by Progressive Sires, Joe Miller Memorial and the Howard Voegeli Memorial Fund.

<u>Requirements</u>: The applicant must be at least a senior in high school and not yet 22 by *January 1, 2022*, and must have been a National Brown Swiss Member for at least three years including the current year.

Scholarship Guidelines: Applicant must show proof of acceptance for the fall term at an institute for higher education (beyond high school) or transcript of grades from the past term, if already attending college. The applicant must be pursuing an agriculture or dairy-related degree. *Please note: if you have not received an acceptance letter by March* 1^{st} – *please indicate this and send as soon as you receive the letter. Your application will not be considered if we do not have an acceptance letter by* **April 30th**, **2022.**

• The scholarship will be awarded upon completion of the term following announcement of the winner and after the national office receives grade transcripts, with the applicant finishing the term in good standing.

Rules/Judging Procedures

- Applications will be screened by Brown Swiss Association staff members for compliance.
- Three dairy industry or Brown Swiss professionals will make the final selection.
- The recipient will be announced at the 2022 National Annual Meeting in Loveland, CO
- A scholarship or grant may be awarded each year, there is no restriction. The award will be selected based on quality of application.
- A junior may receive a scholarship or grant from the Brown Swiss Association only one time.

Please Note:

This award is very competitive. Sometimes it can come down to details provided. Make sure to read your application for errors and include grade transcripts and letters of recommendation (if required.) If you requested your school to send your grades directly to the national office, do some follow up and make sure they were sent. Any of these details could make a difference in the judge's decision.
